



Lake rules:

Number of Rods:

- Each angler is allowed to use a maximum of 3 fishing rods.

Fishing Stations:

- Fishing stations must be individual.

Equipment and Accessories:

- The use of spomb/rocket for baiting is allowed.
- Nylon must be used as monofilament, with diameters ranging from 0.35 and above.
- The use of a nylon shock leader is mandatory.
- Barbless hooks are required.
- The use of braid is prohibited as both reel line and shock leader, allowed only for spomb and marker.
- Permitted hooks only in the following sizes: 4,6,2.

Allowed Baits:

- Boilies, SKRETTING pellets, hemp, tiger nuts, and canned maize are permitted.
- Flaked bait and home-cooked grains are not allowed.
- The use of live baits and hooked pastes on the hook is prohibited.

Weighing and Hygiene Material:

- The use of a mat/cradle and fish disinfectant is mandatory.
- Use of retention sacks is prohibited.

Prohibited Fishing Methods:

- Zig rig fishing and the use of the anchor are prohibited.

Use of Boats:

- Use of boat is allowed by groups renting the lake exclusively with a mandatory life jacket.
- Bait boat can be used within a **maximum range of 100 meters only** in the following stations: 3,4,5,6,7.

Visitors and Checks:

- We reserve the right to inspect anglers' hooks and the diameter of fishing lines with a dedicated professional micrometer.
- Anglers must adhere to hygiene and environmental rules.
- Non-compliance with the regulations will result in immediate removal.
- Occasional visitors are not allowed.
- Each angler can bring a non-fishing companion with an additional fee of €10 per day (must be communicated in advance) → for those staying at the farmhouse, it is free of charge.

Services:

- Water, light, power services are available directly at each of the following locations:7,8,9,10.
- Toilet service and outdoor shower (solar) directly on the lake.

These regulations are designed to ensure responsible Carp fishing practices, respecting both the needs of anglers and the protection of the surrounding environment. Compliance is crucial to maintaining the integrity of the fishing location and promoting a sustainable culture of sports fishing.
